CALL TO WORSHIP

- P: The season returns with all its familiarity: Purple paraments, somber messages, and an invitation to receive the ashes of repentance.
- C: The season returns with familiar things but its themes are in every season: the need to repent, to ponder the living meaning of the cross, and to allow the inevitability of death guide the ways we live our lives.
- P: There is an eternal quality to these 40 days, and you and I have come together to draw near and be touched by it.
- C: May we draw near to Jesus, around whom Lent is centered, and in these weeks of devotion, may we be prepared to joyfully celebrate the resurrection in April! Amen.



CALL TO CONFESSION Jeremiah 17:9, 10

- P: Jeremiah says, "The heart is devious above all else; it is perverse; who can understand it?
- C: "I the Lord test the mind and search the heart, to give to all according to their ways." May God have mercy on us! Let us confess our sin.

PRAYER OF CONFESSION

Great God, we see the ashes before us and are reminded of our mortality. We confess that we have not always used the gift of our time wisely; our life on earth is finite and sometimes we wasted it.

We see the cross before us and recall that Jesus taught that whoever would follow him must take up their own cross. We have often chosen to try and follow him without self-denial, and shunned painful sacrifice on his behalf.

We are here because we confess we know this, and we know that we need Your grace! Re-make us in the image of Your Son.

THE IMPOSITION OF ASHES (Optional)

In continuing the Confession of Sin, those who wish to receive ashes, please come forward single file down the center aisle. The rest of the congregation may sit down and remain in the spirit of prayer. After all who desire to receive ashes have done so and returned to their pews, our prayer concludes with these words:

P: Forgive us our sins and bring us with all Your saints to the joy of Christ's resurrection. In his name we pray. Amen.
