CALL TO WORSHIP

- P: In these forty days You lead us into the desert of repentance, that in this pilgrimage of prayer, we might learn to be Your people once more. In sacrifice and service, You bring us back to Your heart.
- *C:* You open our eyes to Your presence in the world, and You free our hands to lead others to the radiant splendor of Your mercy.
- P: Be with us in these journey days, for without You we are lost and will perish.
- *C:* To You alone be dominion and glory, forever and ever. Amen.



CALL TO CONFESSION

PRAYER OF CONFESSION

Our Prayer of Confession is Psalm 51, found in our hymnal as Selection 19 on pp. 571-72. We pray responsively, with the Congregation praying the letters in bold.

In continuing the Confession of Sin, those who wish to receive ashes, please come forward single file down the center aisle. The rest of the congregation may sit down and remain in the spirit of prayer. After all who desire to receive ashes have done so and returned to their pews, our prayer concludes with these words:

- P: Accomplish in us, O God, the work of Your salvation,
- C: That we may show forth Your glory.
- P: By the Cross and Passion of our Savior,
- C: Forgive us our sins and bring us with all Your saints to the joy of Christ's resurrection. In His name we pray. Amen.

ASSURANCE OF PARDON

"For God has destined us not for wrath but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, who died for us, so that whether we are awake or sleep we may live with Him" (I Thessalonians 5:9-10).

By the astounding grace we meet in Jesus who died on the cross for us, taking our place, our sins are forgiven and salvation has been obtained. Let us all say, *C: Thanks be to God!*
