Those who are able please stand.

CALL TO WORSHIP

- P: Ash Wednesday is so different from Advent, Christmas, Epiphany and Easter.
- C: Ash Wednesday is the day of ashes, of confronting our mortality, of confession and reflection.
- P: We begin the season of Lent, a time of somber preparation for the Passion, and also preparation for the Resurrection.
- C: Lent is a time we can draw nearer to the Crucified Jesus and renew our vows of discipleship. Lent gets us ready for Holy Week and Easter, and thereby fortifies us for how to live in this world. Let us worship God!

CALL TO CONFESSION (Joel 2:12, 13)

- P: "Yet even now, says the Lord, return to Me with all your heart, with fasting, with weeping and mourning; rend your hearts and not your garments.
- C: Return to the Lord your God, for God is gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love, and relents from punishing."

PRAYER OF CONFESSION

A: Holy and righteous, yet approachable and forgiving God, we confess that we have not earned the favor You show us in this sacrament. We have acted selfishly in the face of great need in the world. We have allowed our spiritual lives to languish when books, recordings, worship services and the counsel of more mature Christians have been available to us. We have not shown the courage to heal from the past when You offer us renewal.

We are grateful for Your offer of presence, hope, forgiveness and love in the elements of Communion. We are grateful that You do not require us to be worthy to receive these elements but reach out in grace through the bread and cup. Enable us to receive these gifts in humility, and in conviction to grow in You.

THE IMPOSITION OF ASHES (Optional)

In continuing the Confession of Sin, those who wish to receive ashes, please come forward single file down the center aisle. The rest of the congregation may sit down and remain in the spirit of prayer. After all who desire to receive ashes have done so and returned to their pews, our prayer concludes with these words:

- P: Accomplish in us, O God, the work of Your salvation,
- C: That we may show forth your glory.
- P: By the Cross and Passion of our Savior,
- C: Forgive us our sins and bring us with all your saints to the joy of Christ's resurrection. In his name we pray. Amen.


